

SEWING A SINGLE-GATHERING BOOK WITH THE FIGURE 8 STITCH




- Fold 3 sheets of paper and tuck the folded sheets inside one another. This is called a gathering.
- Punch 3 holes (or stations) along the fold of your gathering, making sure the holes pass through all the sheets.
- Cut a piece of thread about 3 times the length of your gathering (from head to tail).


SEWING A SINGLE-GATHERING BOOK WITH THE FIGURE 8 STITCH



- Fold 3 sheets of paper and tuck the folded sheets inside one another. This is called a gathering.

- 1. Insert the thread into gathering through the middle station from the outside to the inside.
- From the inside of the gathering, insert thread through the top station and pull tight.
- Re-insert the thread into the bottom station from the outside.
- 4. Finish the stich by inserting the thread back out of the 2nd or middle station from the inside.
- 5. Tie the ends together around the outer yarn.

- Finish the stich by inserting the thread back out of the 2nd or middle station from the inside.
